







Webinar on Building Back Better: The Economic Stimulus By Ms. Sanjana Kadyan and Dr. Avanindra Nath Thakur

The Department of Economics, College of Vocational Studies in collaboration with IQAC organized an online webinar, 'Building Back Better: The Economic Stimulus' on July 26,2020. Ms. Sanjana Kadyan, assistant director in Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, IES and Dr. Avanindra Nath, Associate Professor, OP Jindal Global University were the guest speakers for the webinar Ms. Sanjana Kadyan gave a brief explanation of the dilemma faced by the government while formulating policies in the lockdown period. Ms. Kadyan explained the various measures taken by the government during various stages of the lockdown. Ms. Kadyan further shed light on the GDP predictions of various countries and also presented a comparison between various sectors pre and post the covid situation. After an insightful session by Ms. Sanjana, Dr. Avanindra discussed the structure of Indian economy before the COVID condition and its impact on various sectors of Indian economy. She explained the stimulus measures taken by the Indian government to reduce the magnitude of the damage caused by this unprecedented disaster. 


The webinar ended on a positive note with the speaker answering some of the doubts of the attendees which cleared the uncertainties and misconceptions that they had in their mind


Guidance on Stock Market By Mr. Aakash Ahuja


