Role of Netaji and INA in Indian Freedom Struggle between 1945 – 1947


On the occasion of the 125th Birth Centenary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Karvan 21, the annual fest of History Department of CVS organized the *Dr. P. L. Malhotra Memorial lecture* on the topic- **Role of Netaji and INA in Indian Freedom Struggle between 1945 – 1947,** headed by Prof. Kapil Kumar and Prof. B.C. Tripathi, Chairman, Governing Body, CVS. The Honourable speakers provided the students with an amalgamation of multiple facts of Netaji's life after clearing the ICS exam in London which he dropped off as a career option and went to play a huge part in the India's freedom struggle which are remembered till date.

Important facts that are often overlooked when studying the independence struggle were brought to light like how he was the one who raised the first Indian National Army (INA), Azad Hind Fauj in 1943 and started an armed coup and inspired thousands of Indian youths to join the struggle for independence from the British colonial rule.

The speakers highlighted how Subhash Chandra Bose was a prominent figure in India's freedom struggle. He was not only an efficient leader but played an important role in the freedom struggle. He is remembered for his active and aggressive role in Indian freedom struggle. His style of leadership was not only attractive but was a motivating factor for many to take up the cause for Indian freedom struggle. Discussion on why his name has been almost vanished from mainstream history also took place.

The students were filled with fascination and took part in the discussions being initiated by the speakers, quite actively. Any doubt or questions were taken up towards the end of the webinar.
