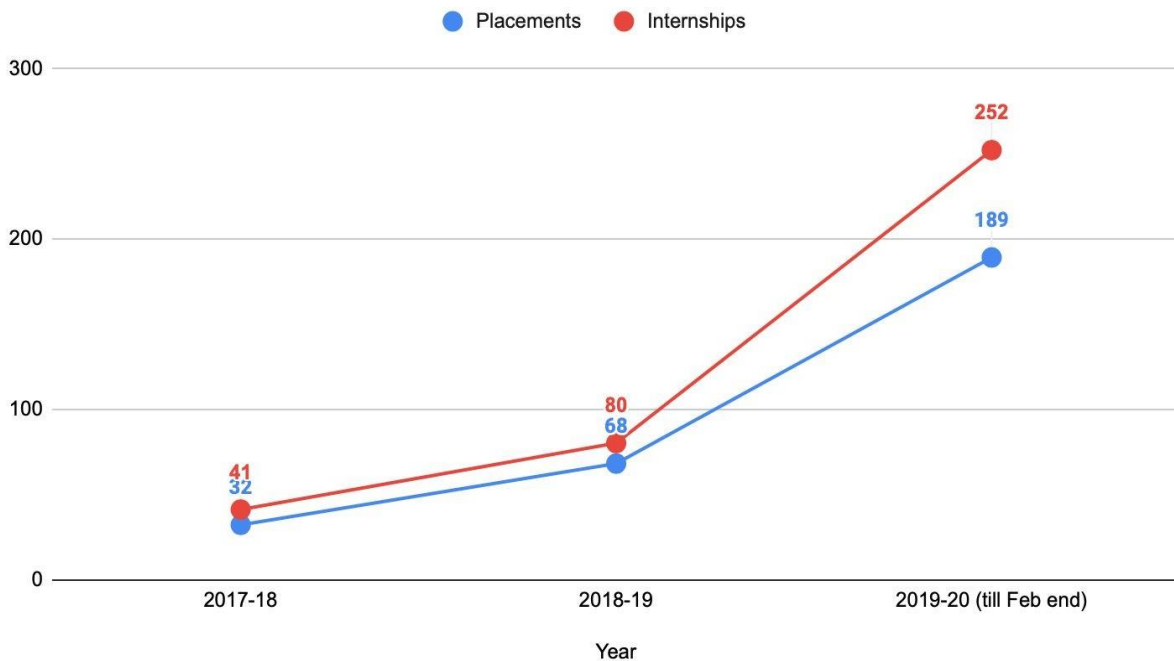

## GREEN BRIGADE

Green Brigade, the environment society of CVS is a platform through which students enlighten themselves and others about pressing environmental issues like plastic pollution, climate change, deforestation, among others and sustainable development.

Green Brigade has been active throughout the year and organized various events – Tree Plantation Drives, Talks, Workshops, Nukkad Nataks, Nature Walks and Outreach activities to develop Green Good Behaviour among students.

## ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR ARE:

- a. The Green Brigade organized a Tree Plantation Drive in the college campus to celebrate Independence Day and the college Foundation Day. Along with this, flags made from seed paper- the base is made from waste and recycled cotton fibers with poppy, marigold etc seeds embedded in it- were distributed. This was in collaboration with an organization called **Vriksh Garage**.
- b. The Green Brigade conducted their Orientation on 24 August 2019 for the academic year 2019-2020 to welcome more green crusaders to join their brigade. The Green Brigade participated in the ‘**Swachhata Hi Seva**’ programme initiated by the Government of India to make the college campus and surrounding areas more green, clean and free of single-use plastic. In this regard, the society has launched a campaign titled, ‘Beat Plastic Pollution’ to obliterate single-use plastic from the college campus.
- c. **Project Gyaan**- Awareness Drive in SDMC Primary School, Chirag Delhi, held on 16 September 2019. This awareness drive on ‘Beat Plastic Pollution’ was organized for around 300 students of grade IV and V. Animated films on the hazardous effects of plastic were showcased to the students, along with a **workshop** of crafting paper bags from old newspapers. In addition, a **Plantation Drive** was organized in the school and native trees of Delhi like Neem, Amaltas and Gulmohar were planted as well as the initiative of ‘**Adopt a Tree**’ was started in the school wherein the names of the school students were written on cardboard placards which were then placed near the saplings and the students promised to nurture these saplings. Lastly, a **Vertical Hanging Garden** was made from up- cycled plastic bottles along with students and the teachers.
- d. **Cleanliness Drive** in the college campus was organized on 1 October 2019, to collect all the single-use plastic waste. 35 students participated in this drive and four gunny sacks (approximately 20 kgs of waste) of plastic waste was collected and was given to Beach Warriors for proper recycling. **Shramdaan and Swachhata Pledge** were taken on 2 October 2019. Around 30 volunteers participated in this activity to spread awareness about the catastrophic effects of plastic on our environment and health.
- e. **Recycling Project**, 250 cloth bags made from up-cycled cloth materials like old sarees, dupattas, upholstery linen etc, were distributed in **the vicinity the residents of K-Pocket**,

**Sheikh Sarai-II** and plastic waste was collected from their homes for proper recycling. The material for the cloth bags was donated by the students, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college during the Cloth Collection Drive held in the college campus on 11 and 13 September 2019 and these were crafted into bags by women workers (Mrs Shahinoor Begum and Mrs Sharda) and were finally distributed to spread awareness about Plastic Pollution. **Handmade tags made from medicine wrappers and other discarded packaging material, to reduce paper waste, were attached along with the bags.**

- f. A Plog Run was organized, wherein plastic waste was collected from the streets of Sheikh Sarai-II and lastly, a Swachhata Pledge was conducted to give up single-use plastic and to make the campus as well as the surroundings clean and plastic-free. Around 50kgs of plastic waste was collected during the plog run. **A Certificate of Excellence has been awarded to the College by the Beach Warriors for ‘Opting Zero Plastic Model’.** On 8 August 2019, some members of the Green Brigade attended the **‘Plastic Tide Turners Challenge’** training session organized by WWF-India at their head office. Refillable white board markers for the teaching staff of the college have been introduced to reduce plastic wastage. Single-use plastic cutlery and straws, stirrers have been removed in the College canteen to curb plastic waste.
- g. The Green Brigade organized a Nature Walk to Delhi’s first Heritage Park and Arboretum, the magnificent Sunder Nursery. An E-Waste Collection Drive was conducted in the college and 39 kgs of mixed electronic waste was collected and submitted to Chintan Environmental Research and Action Group for ethical and proper recycling. The Green Brigade had organized a talk on **‘Humanity and Environment’** by Mr Chinu Kwatra, founder of Khushiyaan Foundation and Beach Warriors on 28 January 2020. The students from the society are actively participating in the ongoing Aravalli Bachao silent protests to save 74,000 acres of forest land being destroyed in the name of development and Clean Yamuna Campaign organized by Khushiyaan Foundation.
- h. The college has been felicitated with the ‘World Award for Value Education’ by the Indian Institute of Ecology and Environment and the World Assembly on Value Education. In the wake of digital-driven education and awareness, the society has initiated numerous social media initiatives like starting Instagram, YouTube and Twitter handles to disseminate information on pertinent environmental concerns, Green Tip of the Week to promote sustainability and sustainable practices, commemorating various environmental days and elucidating green tips for various festivals including Raksha Bandhan, Diwali, Holi etc. so as to celebrate them in the most sustainable way.

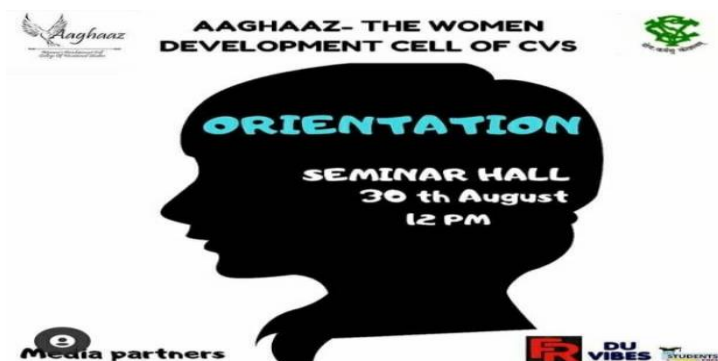
#### **AAGHAAZ, THE WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL**

- 26th July, 2019 - CYBER CRIME AWARENESS Workshop



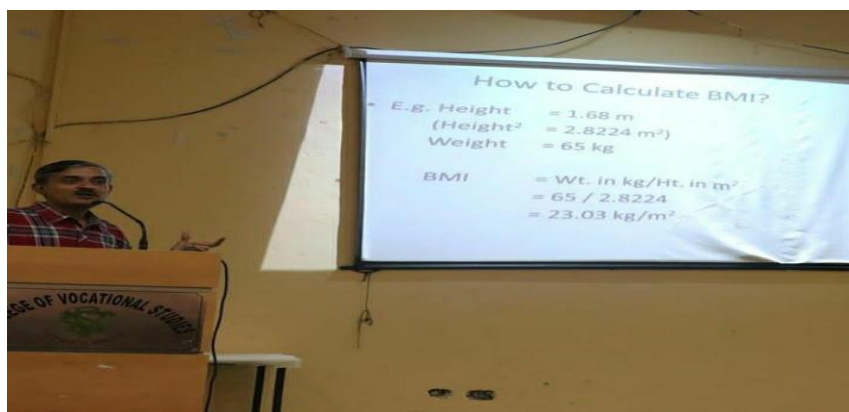

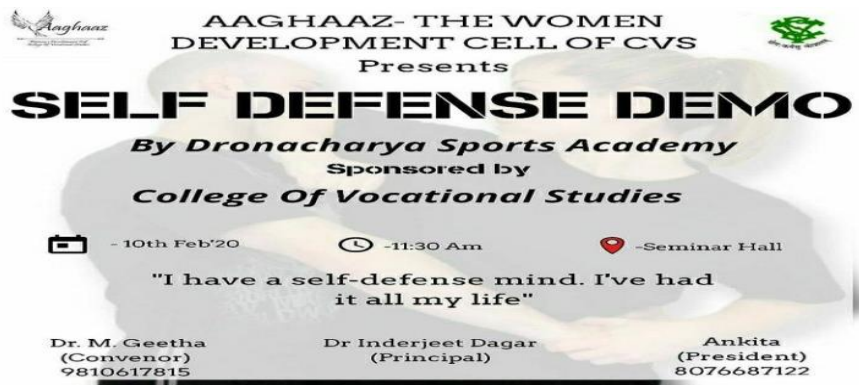

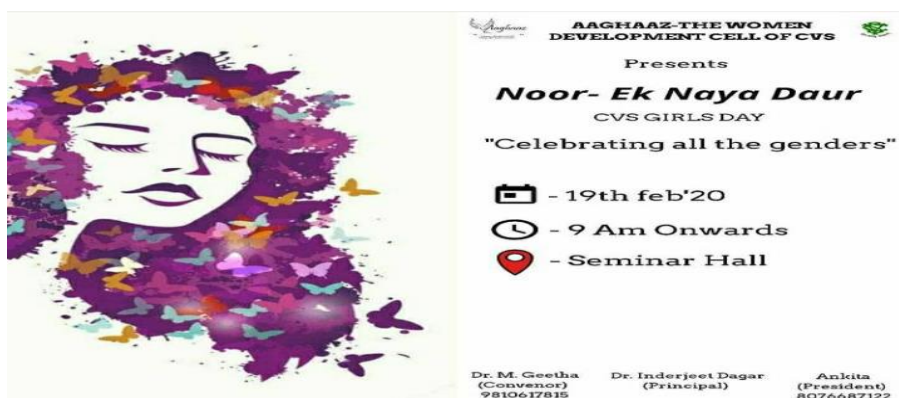
