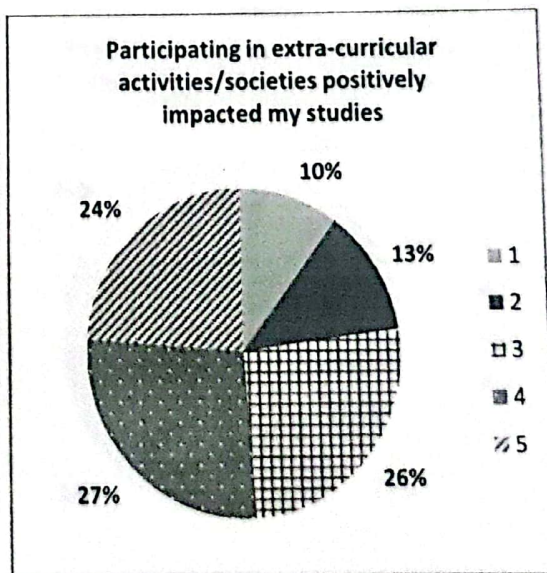
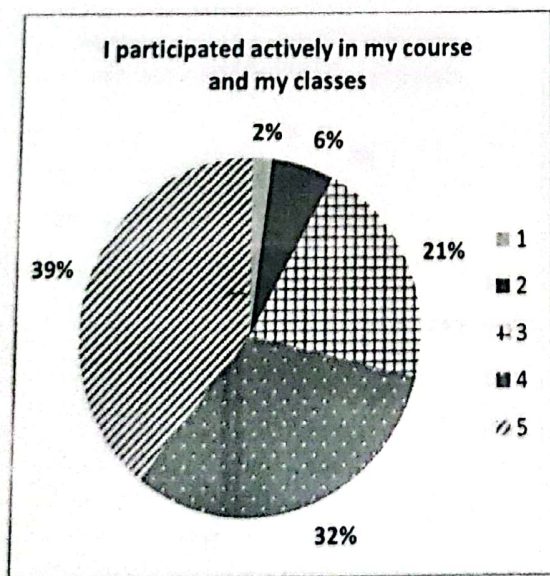
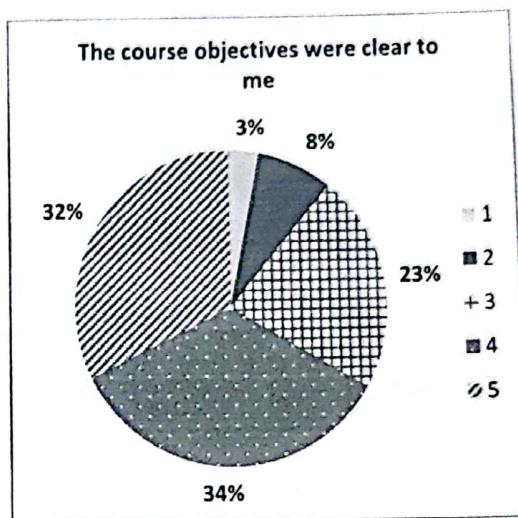
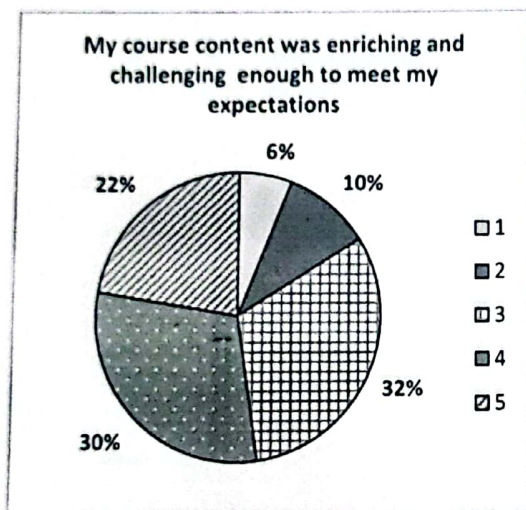
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Graphical Analysis



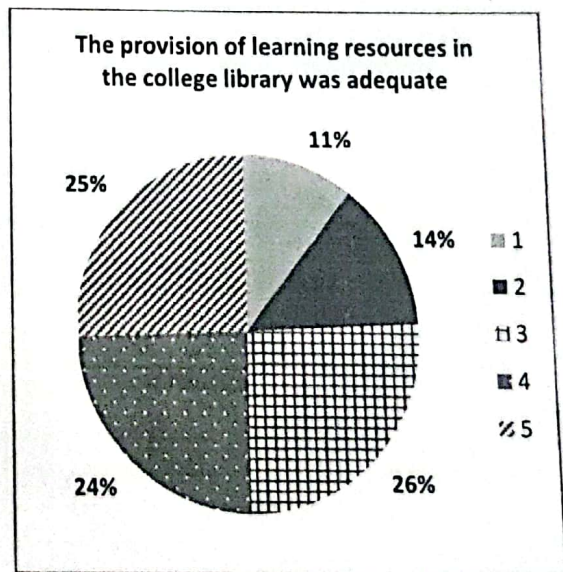
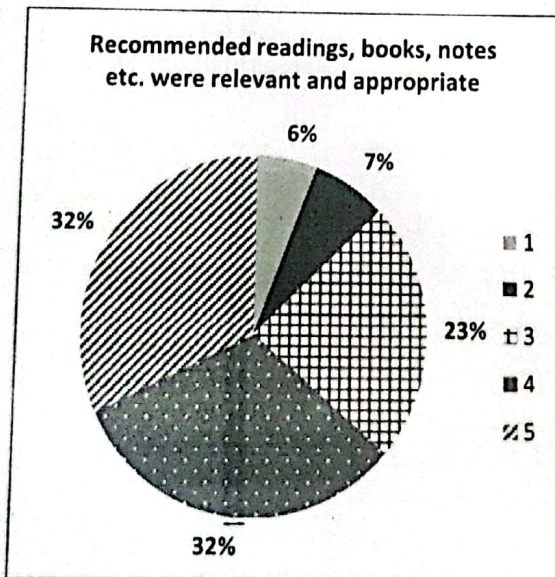
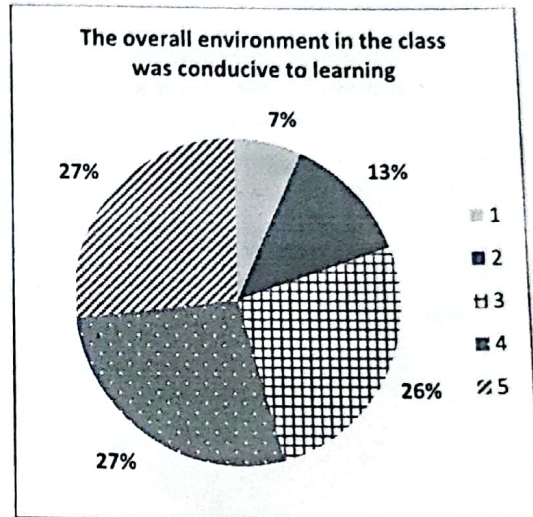
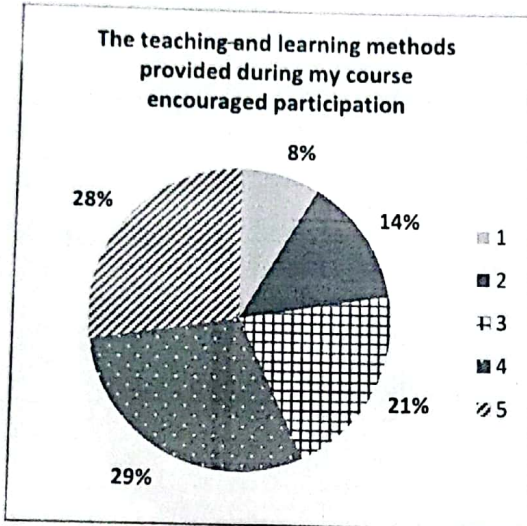
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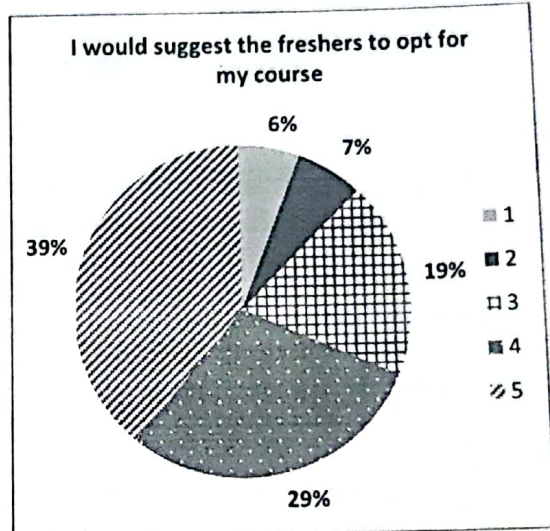
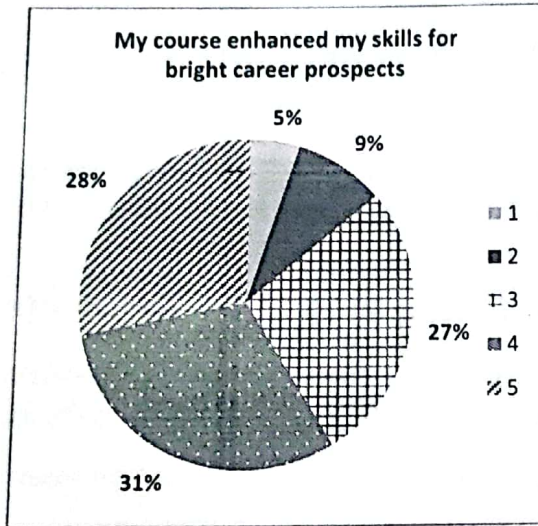
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### ECONOMETRIC ANALYSIS

An econometric analysis using t-test was conducted to analyse the data in order to identify the different criterion deviating significantly from the mean. Following is the result analysis.

#### **One-Sample t test regarding Learning Environment and Teaching Methods:**

One-Sample t-test-revealed that students belonging to majority of courses are significantly satisfied with the content and objectives of the course.

Students belonging to BBE were found to be most satisfied with their course content.

#### **One-Sample t test regarding Learning Environment and Teaching Methods:**

From the One-Sample t-test it can be observed that students belonging to most courses were highly and significantly satisfied with the learning environment and teaching provided to them.

#### **One-Sample t test regarding Learning Resources:**

From the One-Sample t-test it can be observed that students belonging to BA (H) English, BA (H) Economics, BA (H) History, BA (VS) MMRB and BMS do not find the resources available at the library or the ones provided by the respective teachers to be appropriate.

It should also be noted that most of the Vocational students, as mentioned in the 'Suggestions' have pointed out the lack of proper resources dedicated to the particular vocational courses.

#### **One-Sample t test regarding participation in course:**

It can be observed that students belonging to all the courses except BSc (H) CS were keen on participating actively in their course and classes.

#### *Extracurricular activities*

**54.1% of the passing students were a member of at least 1 college society**

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### One-Sample t test regarding impact of society participation on studies

While students belonging to BA (H) English, BA (H) Economics, BA (H) History, BSc (H) CS, and BMS believed that society participation interfered with their studies, other students felt the opposite.

It should be observed that NONE of the vocational students believed that societies interfered with their studies.

### College Placement

Over 60% students did NOT participate in the college placement process

Major reasons for not participating in placement drive as mentioned below:

- 1) "Plan to pursue higher studies" (mentioned by 152 students)
- 2) "Placement opportunities were not related to my course" (mentioned by 90 students)
- 3) "The package was too low" (mentioned by 61 students)
- 4) "Participate in personal business/start-up" (mentioned by 18 students)

### Future outlook


#### One-Sample t test regarding future outlooks of the course

Using t-test, it was observed that all courses, except BSc (H) CS believed their course improved their future outlooks and would recommend the course to other freshers.

### Career options upon course completion

Upon the completion of their respective courses, students opted the following career options:

- 1) Pursue job in corporate or an existing organization (opted by 78 students)
- 2) Prepare for competitive examinations (opted by 72 students)
- 3) Masters/Higher studies in the same or allied field (opted by 155 students)
- 4) Joint Family Business/Start-up (opted by 43 students)

  
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
