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## STUDENT NOTICE

Second Phase Allotment for SEC, VAC and AECs in Cluster Colleges Semester I (2022-23) for students who wish to study courses that are not being offered at the College of Vocational Studies.

This is to notify to all students of semester I (2022-23) that as per the course curriculum you are required to study one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), one Value Added Course (VAC) and one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in the first semester. The SEC and VAC as mentioned in List I (12 in each) are being offered by our college. In case a student wishes to choose one of the SEC or VAC's mentioned in List II, the student shall be required to attend classes of the SEC or VAC at one of the cluster colleges offering that paper (mentioned in List II) in order to study the same.

Similarly, all students of semester I (2022-23) have to study one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in the first semester.

*(Students have to study Environmental Science: Theory into Practice - I and any chosen Indian Language (Course 1) from AEC Pool in flip mode in Semester I and Semester II. Similarly, Environmental Science: Theory into Practice - II and Course 2 of the same Language as chosen in First Year shall be studied in the flip mode in Semester III and Semester IV.)*

Given below is the List III of Ability Enhancement Courses (Indian Languages) being offered by the College of Vocational Studies and other cluster colleges. In case you want to pick any of the courses other than these courses offered by the college you will have to go to the cluster college to study the same.

  - 2. All the Vocational Courses students have to compulsory study Environmental Science as AEC in Sem I**
