1. Seminar on Sustainability

Green Brigade feels proud to be invited by the college faculty to join an important seminar with the motive to promote sustainability on 4th July 2022. It was organised by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Ministry of Education.

The speaker, Ms. Sanchita Pandita brought up the motive of the session and gave us a small introduction. She started with the single-use plastic ban implemented by the government on 1st July, stating some examples like plastic straws, cups, cutlery, etc. The most dangerous is polythene because it takes a lot of

time to decompose. A few teachers and students also presented their points of view, stating some in-life examples for students to understand. After this, the speaker showed us a form by the Government of India for calculating sustainable resource use in the college. She talked about renewable energies like solar panels, which help our environment, but we don't have enough revenue yet, to depend on renewable energies.

We also discussed the use of solar panels in college and the surplus energy generated by them. There were also some methods to calculate the amount of water and electricity consumed by the college. In Delhi, 20 kl of water is free of cost per month, if the consumer exceeds it, they have to pay the whole cost. She also talked about wind energy and the importance of constructing windmills where strong winds are present.

She also told us about great sustainable inventions by students of our age in different colleges and inspired us to contribute to the environment. Some members of Green Brigade raised a few questions which were then discussed by the speaker and the teachers present.

Report:

Green Brigade collaborated with NSS for a campaign to promote awareness regarding the ban on single-use plastic with the guidance of MCD South Zone on the 11th and 12th of July 2022. We aimed to make the general public aware that single-use plastic drastically impacts the environment in a harmful way.

On 11th July, the members travelled with NSS to J Block and PVR market, Saket. The MCD officials welcomed us and gave us a short introduction to the campaign's motive. They led us through the markets with a loudspeaker, informing the people and the shop owners about the single-use plastic ban implemented by the government. We entered many shops to check their plastic usage and caught a glimpse of how MCD works.

While going around the J block market, we encountered Ruby Makhija who enlightened us more about the single-use plastic ban. She informed us that the ban on single-use plastic was implemented in December 2021 but gained momentum in July because of the government specifying the items. She even taught us how to identify legal and illegal plastic bags. Further, we got to know that the most polluting plastic element is not polythene bags, but cigarette ends.

She introduced us to Project Vikalp, started by her in collaboration with the MCD. Under this initiative, she set up stalls to sell cloth bags in different areas. The consumers can get these bags for merely INR 20. Even more, they can get this amount back by returning the bags to any of the Vikalp Stalls. The bags even have a QR code for users to scan and know the location of other Vikalp stalls. This idea reduces the financial burden on people who can't afford extra bags and ensures that people don't leave the bags at home, purchasing goods in plastic bags once again.

12th July marked day two of this campaign. On this day, we travelled with NSS to the main market in Bhikaji Cama Place. There we spoke to a lot of shopkeepers along with MCD officials about the ban on single-use plastic. We were delighted to find a few shops which had prior knowledge about this and were already using paper bags and paper cups. We all showed our appreciation and encouragement by clapping for them. It was very inspiring to see that the shopkeepers that did not know about the implementation of the ban were kind enough to listen to us and agreed to change their ways and switch to cloth bags and paper plates instead of using single-use plastics. The MCD officials were also very cooperative and knowledgeable and worked hard to help us succeed in our initiative. Initially, we started by going to shops with the officials but later on, we divided ourselves into groups and went to different shops to be more efficient. Ultimately, in just one day we were able to over 20 shops.





Overall, this round was a success, with a lot of new information that was appreciated by all participants and judges.

Lets Talk Nature


