Team ComSoc visited an industry of **Parle** located in **Bahadurgarh**, **Haryana** on **4th April 2022**. Around **50 members** of the society including the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, departmental heads and the organising committee members were accompanied by **3 teachers** during the visit.

The whole team had gathered in the college at around 10 AM, which was followed by a bus journey of 2-3 hours. They reached the factory at 1 PM.

Parle, founded in 1929, is a well reputed company and many of its products like Parle G, Monaco and a variety of other biscuits are famous all around the world. The factories situated in Bahadurgarh, Haryana and Neemrana, Rajasthan are the two mother factories of Parle. It also has many other manufacturing units located all over the country.

After reaching the factory, the team was welcomed by the staff members and given a tour of the whole industry. Firstly, they were taken to the processing unit where they observed the manufacturing of Parle's well known products like Parle G, Monaco and Krack Jack. Thereafter, everyone was asked to be seated inside a room where a presentation was put on display. The presentation was an animated short film which explained in detail about the working of the Parle industry, the products manufactured by them, the ingredients used etc.

This was followed by a very interactive Q&A session in which the students asked numerous questions related to the sale and revenue of Parle products and their future plans for growth of the company. All these doubts were well clarified by one of their employees. In addition to this, she provided information regarding various commodities invented by Parle which are prominent not only in India, but a few foreign countries as well. She even mentioned that their highest selling product is Parle G.

In the end, some refreshments were distributed to the whole team and a group picture was clicked to be kept as a memory of the visit. Everyone then came back to the college in the evening.

Overall, the industrial visit turned out to be a great experience for the whole society and they got many insights about the working structure of Parle.

The commencement of **ARCANOM'22**, the annual event of ComSoc, the Commerce Society of College of Vocational Studies, took place on **26th and 27th April 2022** and attracted an audience of **100+** people from different colleges.

ARCANOM'22 started off with its opening ceremony in the **amphitheatre** of the college which consisted of a jam session by **Saahell** and **Avi Rajput**, two instagram sensations.





Team ComSoc welcomed the guests of honour and the entire crowd danced to the tunes of both the singers. With an audience of 250+ students, the opening ceremony marked a great beginning to the event.

Thereafter, Round 1 of both, Com-A-Lympics and House of Cases, the two sub events of ARCANOM'22, was conducted which was then followed by a few other rounds that were held in the **seminar hall**, **conference room**, **college ground**, and witnessed a participation of **70+students**.

The rounds took place smoothly and summed up the first day of ARCANOM'22 successfully. Day Two began with double the excitement of the qualified participants as well as Team ComSoc!

COM-A-LYMPICS

- Treasure Hunt took place as a part of 1st round of Com-A-Lympics which was a success with over 40 participants.
- Round 2 involved a pictionary and pitching the product with about 30 participants.
- Round 3 involved a life sized version of Snakes and Ladders with a few twists and turns.
- Com-A-Lympics, the Fun Event of ARCANOM, was won by a team of four: Geet Narula, Nelson Malik, Manit Puneyani, and Yash Aaryan Dua from CVS, Deshbandhu College and Sri Aurobindo College respectively while the First Runner Ups were Piyush, Harshita Sharma and Suhani Bothra representing Ramlal College and Institute of Home Economics.

HOUSE OF CASES

- House of Cases, the case studies explanation and bidding round was conducted with 30 participants.
- The 2nd and final round involved solving mysteries and bidding with 10 participants.
- In the Flagship event, House of Cases, the First position was given to a team of three: Saloni Aggarwal, Dhruv Aggarwal and Saanvi Sharma who represented, CVS whereas the Second position was taken by Anjali Rao, Bhavya Verma and Haripriya Mulidhar from Sri Venkateswara College.

The Final Round of both the events were conducted flawlessly. The sponsors of the event, **PearlxStudio** and **Intake Education**, set up their booths in the **college amphitheatre** on both the days of the event. They welcomed a crowd of approximately 200 people who appreciated and loved the experience.





INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO COCA-COLA

October 7, 2022

On **7th October 2022**, Team ComSoc successfully organised an industrial visit to the **Coca-Cola Happiness Factory** situated in **Greater Noida**, **Uttar Pradesh**. **32** members along with **two faculty members** visited the factory to acquire knowledge about the basic working, production and management process of the company.

The students gathered in front of the college entrance at around 9:30 in the morning. Following a bus journey of 2 hours, they reached the venue at 11:30 am.

Coca-Cola company is a widely famous American multinational beverage corporation which was founded in 1892. Best known for the production of Coca-Cola, its headquarters is situated in Atlanta, Georgia, United States. Currently operating 58 water-intensive bottling plants in India, the biggest one is situated in Greater Noida which the team visited.


After reaching the venue, the students were guided by two employees and were given a briefing of rules and guidelines to be obeyed by everyone inside the factory. This was followed by an overview about the main products of the company such as Mazza, Thums up, Sprite etc. and an interesting exhibition of old advertisements designed by the company. Then an informative short film was shown to the students which contained a bunch of interesting facts like the company has over 3000+ products and 500+ brands.

After that, the students were taken inside the vault where the manufacturing process was explained. The whole team observed how the cans are manufactured, the quality tests taken place and what is done with the rejected ones. Everyone was also made aware of the fact that only 2 people in the world know the secret formula of 'Coca-Cola'. The whole team was told that the average production of the cans is 10 to 12 lakhs per day and a record had been made by producing 37 lakhs cans in 24 hours. Thereafter, the evolution of their bottles was shown which was followed by an insightful Q&A session. Everyone's questions were answered very patiently.

Before leaving, unlimited drinks were offered to the team and the students thoroughly enjoyed their time by playing some fun VR games together. At last, a group photo was clicked and everyone reached the college at around 4 in the evening.

The industrial visit to the Coca-Cola factory enriched everyone's practical knowledge and provided the society a great opportunity to learn and gain some experience through demonstration and interaction.



- This event was won by Seerat Mehra, Gauransh Juneja and Bhavya of the College of Vocational Studies.



Overall, the webinar proved to be quite informative and fructuous for the students.





INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SEBI

On 16th March 2023, Team ComSoc successfully organised an industrial visit to the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) office located in INA, Delhi. 70 members along with two faculty members visited the office with the objective of learning about the financial markets and the functioning of the regulatory framework governing the Indian securities market.

SEBI is a statutory body established on April 12,1992 in accordance with the provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992. The basic function of the SEBI is to protect the interest of investors in securities and to promote the regulation of the securities market.

The members were divided into **two batches** of 35 each. The first batch reached the office at 11 am and received a warm welcome. They were escorted inside the conference room where the students were briefed by the **Northern Regional Manager of SEBI, Ms. Nanu Kaur Ma'am** about SEBI's role in regulating the securities market and promoting the investors' interests. She then elucidated the history of SEBI, its integration with regional stock exchanges as well as the need for exchange in the market and the agencies that look after it. She further talked about the depository system and elaborated upon SEBI's role as a regulator that ensures fair trading in the market.

Major functions of SEBI were discussed along with the legal framework and its enforcement powers. After the basic briefing, students were made aware of the do's and don'ts for investing in the financial markets and the necessary precautions to be kept in mind for the same. The manager then conducted a Q&A session to ensure that the information was well grasped by everyone. Moreover, she showed some videos to create awareness about numerous issues like unrealistic returns, SEBI's online grievance redressal system, SCORES, etc.

Thereafter, the students met the **Director of Northern Regional Area, Mr. Rajesh Kumar Dangeti**, who emphasised on the importance of research before investing in a financial asset. This was followed by a tour of the SEBI office, where the students witnessed real-time trading sessions and learnt about the cutting-edge technologies used there.

The visit concluded with the distribution of snacks and booklets containing information about SEBI and the financial markets. Finally, a group photo was clicked. The first batch of students left, followed by the arrival of the second batch at 12 pm who had a similar experience that continued for an hour.

Overall, the industrial visit to Securities and Exchange Board of India enhanced the financial acumen and practical knowledge of the students. It certainly presented the attendees with an excellent exposure to learn and acquire financial expertise through observation.
